- Each resident can have 2 visitors at a time.
- Occasionally it happens that the screener overlooks that there are 2 visitors already visiting the
  resident and allows more people in. In situations like that, we rely on the visitors to report back
  to the screening desk if there are already 2 people visiting. We ask for your cooperation to
  ensure that we don't have too many visitors with the resident at a time.
- Please ensure that while visiting, your mask remains in place, covering your mouth and your nose. Wearing your mask properly, along with hand hygiene is key to preventing future outbreaks and keeping our residents safe while ensuring that visits with our residents continue to occur without interruption.

Our staff have been very busy decking the halls for the Christmas season. When you are in Salem Home visiting your resident, please take a moment to enjoy the festive atmosphere that has been created.
